On May 28, 2026, the parties filed an amended stipulated motion requesting the Court issue an order staying this proceeding until December 31, 2027. The parties have agreed to stay this proceeding until December 31, 2027, consistent with the stipulated stay entered in *IGWA v. IDWR*, Ada County Dist. Ct., Case No. CV01-23-13173 on January 21, 2025. The Court in an exercise of its discretion will grant the amended stipulated motion for stay on the basis it is unopposed.

THEREFORE, BASED ON THE FOREGOING, THE FOLLOWING ARE HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The amended stipulated motion for stay is hereby granted.
2. All proceedings in the above-captioned matter are stayed until December 31, 2027, with the stay commencing after the filing of the settled agency record with the Court in this proceeding.
3. Notice is hereby given that a status conference in the above-captioned matter is set for December 21, 2027, at 1:30 p.m. (MT) at the Snake River Basin Adjudication Courthouse, 253 – 3rd Avenue North, Twin Falls, Idaho. Parties may participate in person or remotely through telephone or video conference using the remote meeting application ZOOM.
