DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY

This is a Director's Report of Deferred *De Minimis* Domestic and/or Stock Water Use submitted by the Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR).

INTRODUCTION

A Motion for Determination of Deferred *De Minimis* Domestic and/or Stock Water Use (Motion), as well as a Notice of Claim to Water Right, was received by the Court on November 18, 2022, for water right claim no. 86-12158. The Claimant published notice of the Motion, and has now completed his examination of the water right claim. The examination was conducted by Jared Klay, Water Resource Agent, Adjudication Section, on behalf of the Director. The materials used in and results of the examination of the elements of water right claim no. 86-12158 are discussed below.

DISCUSSION

Priority Date

The claimed priority date is November 1, 1968. Nez Perce County parcel data shows a built date of 1992. However, USGS Earth Explorer data shows that home was visible in historic air photo dated 9/11/1953.

The priority date is recommended as November 1, 1968.

Point of Diversion

The claimed point of diversion is located on Nez Perce County parcel RP37N03W012524. The location of the point of diversion is described as Township 37 North, Range 03 West, Section 1, SENW. The claimant provided maps that clearly identifies the location of the well. According to the Nez Perce County parcel data, Richard Wolff owns the property at the points of diversion. The point of diversion is recommended as claimed.

Source

The source claimed is "groundwater". The documents in the claim file describes the claimed source as a well. The source for water diverted from a well is ground water. The source claimed under 86-12158 is recommended as claimed.

Place of Use

The claimed place of use is located on Nez Perce County parcel RP37N03W012524. The location of the place of use is described as Township 37 North, Range 03 West, Section 1, SENW and Govt Lot #3 (NENW). According to the Nez Perce County parcel data, Richard & Shelly Wolff own the property described as the claimed place of use. The place of use is recommended as claimed.

Purpose of Use and Period of Use

The claimed purpose of use is for domestic use for 1 home and 1 shop and for stockwater use. Evidence of domestic structures is visible on aerial photography provided by the claimant.

Stockwater use for 1-4 horses confirmed with claimant through e-mail on August 6, 2023.

The claimed year-round season of use is recommended as claimed.

Quantity

The claimed quantity is 0.06 cubic feet per second ("cfs") which is within the typical range of diversion rates associated with domestic and stockwater use according to Appendix 1 of IDWR's Adjudication Memorandum #58 and #4. Specifically, 0.04 cfs was claimed for domestic use of 1 home and 1 shop and 0.02 cfs was claimed for stockwater use for 1 barn and 1 pasture. Appendix 1 of IDWR's Adjudication Memorandum #58 lists a typical diversion rate for up to 50 head of stock at 0.02 cfs. Appendix 1 of IDWR's Adjudication Memorandum #4 lists a typical diversion rate for domestic use at 0.04 cfs. The quantity recommended is 0.06 cfs.

CONCLUSION

There is sufficient evidence to recommend water right claim 86-12158, as claimed, for domestic and stockwater use. Pursuant to Judge Wildman's *Order Amending Procedures in the SRBA for Adjudication of Deferred De Minimis Stockwater Claims*, dated *October 17, 2017*, the Director submits this Director's Report of Deferred *De Minimis* Domestic and/or Stock Water Use, Claim No. 86-12158, which includes the recommendation of deferred *de minimis* water right no. 86-12158.
