On April 1, 2004, a ***Partial Decree Pursuant to I.R.C.P. 54(b)*** was issued for the water right listed above. On February 3, 2026, the Idaho Department of Water Resources notified the Court that the Source element for the water right was not included on the ***Partial Decree***. In April 2004, the Special Master took judicial notice of the Director's Report for this water right and issued a Special Master's Report and Recommendation based on the elements as set forth in the Director's Report, with the exception of the Domestic Purpose of Use, which was not recommended. The Director's Report identified the source as groundwater but was inadvertently omitted from the Partial Decree, due to a clerical error.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the ***Partial Decree Pursuant to I.R.C.P. 54(b)*** for each water right listed above is hereby amended *nunc pro tunc* to correct the clerical error.




