

**NOTICE OF FILING OF WATER
SETTLEMENT PURSUANT TO
STIPULATED PROCESS FOR
EFFECTUATING A
SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

In accordance with the Court's approved Stipulated Process for Effecting a Settlement Agreement, the Coeur d'Alene Tribe ("Tribe"), hereby provides notice that all the non-federal parties executed the Settlement Agreement. A copy of the Executed Settlement Agreement with Exhibits is filed with this notice in a set of four (4) binders.

The Tribe and all non-federal parties have also executed, via DocuSign, a stipulated water

right form for each of the water rights being settled as part of the Settlement Agreement.¹ A partial decree also accompanies each stipulated water right form. The executed stipulated water rights and draft partial decrees are being filed in three (3) binders and are tabbed to correspond to the Settlement Agreement Exhibits for easy cross-reference. A zip drive is also being filed that contains a folder with the digital GIS files with the location of each settled wetland water right, seep water right, and spring water right. The zip drive also contains a folder that has a complete electronic copy of the Settlement Agreement and folder with electronic copies of the executed stipulated water rights with word versions of the partial decrees. The Tribe and non-federal parties worked with the Idaho Department of Water Resources to finalize the stipulated water rights and draft partial decrees.

As noted in the approved Stipulated Process, the United States' will execute the Settlement Agreement and individual stipulated water rights after: (1) the U.S. Congress has enacted and the President has signed legislation authorizing, ratifying, and confirming the Settlement Agreement, and directing the Secretary, to the extent the Settlement Agreement does not conflict with the ratifying legislation, to execute the Settlement Agreement; and (2) if necessary, completion of a conformance process for the Settlement Agreement and revision of any stipulated water rights to eliminate conflicts, if any, with the ratifying legislation (referred to as the "conformance process").


In accordance with the Stipulated Process and Administrative Order 01, the parties understand that the stipulated water rights that have the box checked for "Amended Claims" will be published on the docket for notice on an expedited notice basis of fifteen (15) days for new

¹ The Settlement Agreement includes all claims pending in this subcase except five (5) wetland claims. As part of the negotiated settlement, the five wetlands claims that are not included would be voluntarily dismissed with prejudice after the Settlement Agreement is ratified through federal and state legislation and the United States executes the Settlement Agreement.

objections. Additionally, the parties understand that once the notice period expires and any new objections are filed, the consolidated subcase will be stayed pending state and federal legislation approving the Settlement Agreement, as well as execution of the Settlement Agreement by the United States.

The parties are available for a hearing if it would be helpful to the Court as this matter proceeds.
