ORDER OF PARTIAL DECREE

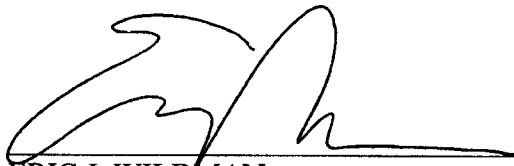
Subcases: 87-2000, 87-2003, 87-2009, & 87-2010

On August 2, 2021, the Idaho Department of Water Resources filed its *Director's Report for Basin 87 Water Rights* which included recommendations for the above-captioned claims. No objections were filed to the recommendations for these claims, and the time for filing such objections has expired. A hearing on the entry of partial decrees for the uncontested claims contained in that *Director's Report* was held before the Court on February 21, 2023.

Prior to that hearing, IDWR contacted the Court and requested that these four uncontested claims be withheld from decree on the basis it was believed they could be affected by a contested claim. After further evaluation, IDWR contacted the Court to inform it that these four claims are not affected by any contested claims and that they are ready for partial decree. Therefore, there is no reason to continue to withhold the above-captioned unobjected to water right claims from *Partial Decree*. The claims will be partially decreed consistent with the elements set forth in the *Director's Report*.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the above-captioned water rights be **decreed** as set forth in the attached *Partial Decree Pursuant to I.R.C.P. 54(b)*.
